## About Fukuoka

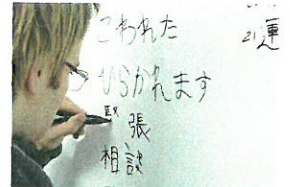
Fukuoka City is located on the island of Kyushu, the southwestern most of Japan's four major islands. With a population of about 1.5 million, it is a city built on commerce and has developed as the cultural and commercial center of the island.

1. Perfectly situated in the center of East Asia making it simple to take a short direct flight to Shanghai, Beijing, Seoul, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Tokyo and many more.
2. Known as "The Gateway to Kyushu, Open to Asia".
3. Ranked 7th Best City in the World for its "Quality of Life" according to the London based Monocle magazine in 2016. This makes Fukuoka the 2nd best city in Japan, behind Tokyo.
4. Fastest growing city in Japan and has the highest ratio of young residents. In addition, it has the highest population growth rate.
5. Second only to Kyoto, Fukuoka has a plethora of higher education options that attract students from around the world.
6. Food prices are affordable and the cost of living is 30% cheaper than Tokyo or Osaka.
7. 10-minute travel time between the downtown area and the airport.
8. Metropolitan city with abundant nature, rich traditions and a long history.
9. Should the need arise, the average time between ambulance arrival and hospital admission is 26 minutes and 33 seconds which is No. 1 among major cities.
10. The water here is safe to drink and the rate of water leakage is just 2.6%, which is lower than other major cities in the world.
11. Does not need to perform rolling blackouts so you never have to worry about losing power.
12. Fukuoka's local government works with budding entrepreneurs through the Fukuoka Startup Café making it a great place to build your own company.



Upon completion of the full 2-year program, the student will receive an associate diploma. The course will be carried out for two years or 1700 hours of study. After graduating, the student can use this degree to find a full-time job in Japan provided that they already have a bachelor's degree.\* The enrollment for this 2-year program is in April.

## COURSES

### Regular Japanese Course

This course includes standard lessons, JLPT preparation and cultural activities throughout the year. The enrollment for the 1-year course is in April & October, 1.5-year course is in October, and 2-year course is in April.

### Pre-University Japanese Course

This course is designed for students who have already received a certain level of Japanese and are focused on continuing their studies at a tertiary or vocational level in order to enroll in a university in Japan. This program develops essay writing and reading as well as Japanese language and listening skills for academic study. It is offered for 1-year or 2-years.\*

### International Career Course (Overseas & Domestic International Students)

This course is for those who have already received a level of Japanese equal to or higher than JLPT2. The student particularly wants to work in Japan or for Japanese companies. This course will prepare you for working in a Japanese company and introduce you to companies and people that are hiring foreign workers throughout Japan.



## International Business Course (Domestic International Students)

This course is for those who have already received a level of Japanese equal to JLPT3 and who wants to attain a level of Japanese equal to or higher than JLPT2. It will develop your Japanese language ability, IT skills and improve your overall business communication knowledge. After graduation, students can enroll for the "International Career Course".



## International Hotel & Tourism Hospitality Course

This course prepares you for a successful career in the field of domestic and international hotel hospitality & tourism management. It will help you to develop your managerial capabilities, business acumen and build a professional network. Besides Japanese study, this program blends theory with practical practice through exciting initiatives by working hotel professionals. After successful course completion, students will receive their diploma and have high possibility to get employed.

## English language course (Japanese Students)

Acquire basic English skills and learn how classes are conducted in foreign countries. You will earn an associate's diploma after 2 years of studying English language in our program. Afterwards you can transfer to the 3rd year of a university in Japan or abroad and earn a bachelor's degree.



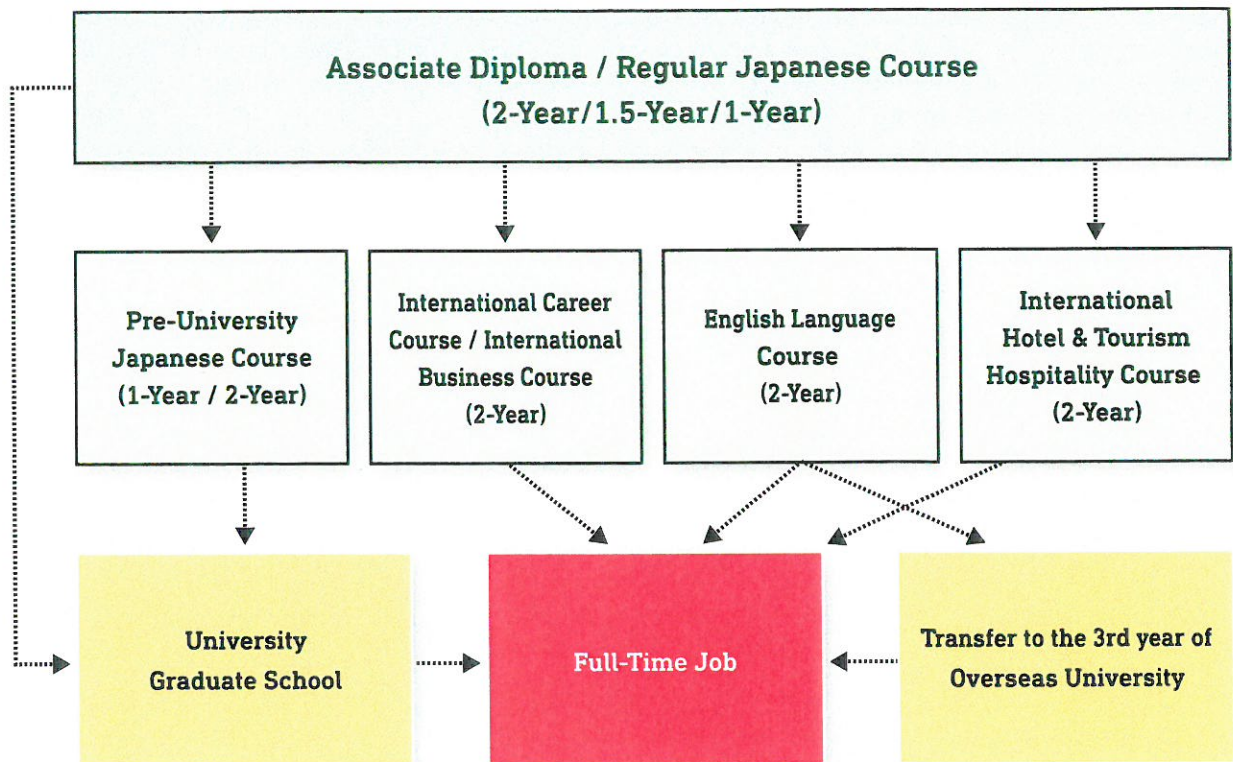

Class size is limited in between 10-20 students.





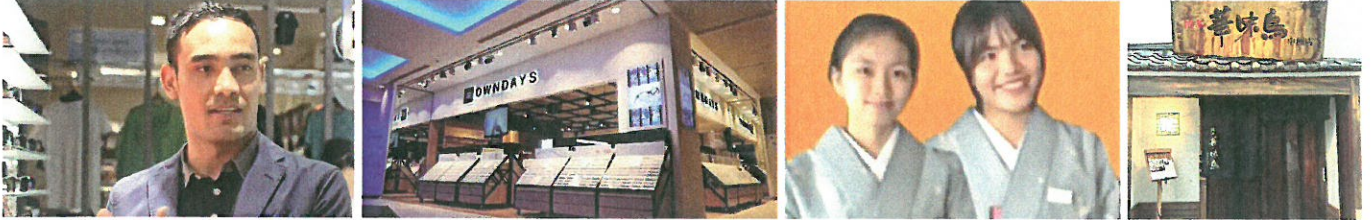

# ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES

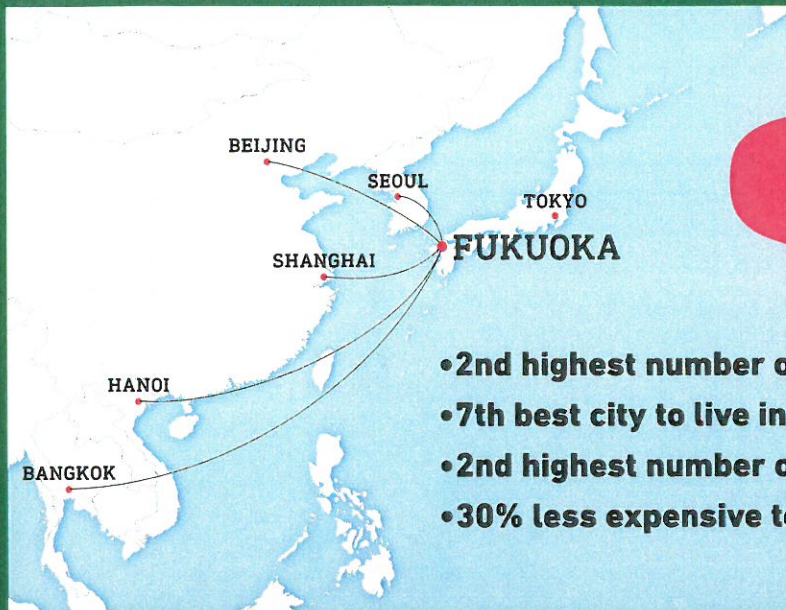
Our dormitories are particularly convenient and a cheap option for the students to live in. Currently we have two dormitories for our students with single & shared room facilities. By bicycle, it takes about 5 to 15 minutes from the dorm to the college. In addition, public transport is available. Each room is fitted with modern equipment including an attached toilet and bath. Communal kitchens and laundry room facilities are also available. Free Wi-Fi internet access is offered for our students in common areas of the dorms. Students will experience a complete international environment by living together and making new friends.



Students are allowed to do a part-time job outside of their study. We have a professional staff readily available dedicated to the employment support. Students can work up to 28 hours per week during school and up to 40 hours per week during long vacation periods. Because we are collaborating with many Japanese companies, after graduation there are numerous opportunities to get a full-time job through and by being associated with our school.
